

ELECTION BOARD MEETING MINUTES

April 20, 2022

Those in attendance: James Holland (Chairman), Mark Kevitt (Vice-Chairman), Peter King (Attorney), and Shari J. Lentz (Secretary)

Chairman, James Holland called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was to review the legal notice from April 9, 2022 edition of The Republic newspaper that listed the candidates for the 2022 Primary Election. The board unanimously approved the notice by acclamation.
