The Auditor shall then promptly notify the Members of the Council giving the Council an opportunity to provide input prior to the vacancy being filled.

The only departments exempt from this are the E911, Sheriff, Jail and the Emergency Management Center.

Bartholomew County Sheriff's Office Shift Differential Premium

Merit Officers

A. Each officer working a shift other than first, regardless of rank, shall receive an additional percentage of pay, which is calculated upon the base salary of a **patrol officer** as defined on the salary ordinance applicable year.

B. This additional pay or "Shift Premium shall be paid to the officer as long as that officer is assigned to that shift.

C. The rate of pay is set by the Bartholomew County Council and shall be according to the following schedule:Second Shift 5%Third Shift 10%

D. "Shift Premium" pay shall be effective January 1, 2013 and shall be paid with the normal payroll schedule. This premium is subject to all applicable taxes and deductions, but is not part of the officer's base pay.
